MADRAS ACT No. I of 1899.

PASSED BY THE GOVERNOR OF FORT ST. GEORGE IN COUNCIL.

[Received the assent of His Excellency the Governor on the 12th
February 1899 and that of His Excellency the Viceroy and
Governor-General on the 1st March 1899; the Governor-
General's assent was first published in the Fort St. George
Gazette of the 14th March 1899.]

An Act to amend Madras Act IV of 1884.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Madras Act IV of 1884 (the
Madras District Municipalities Act, 1884); It is hereby enacted
as follows:—

1. In sub-section (2) of section 191 of the said Act, the
words "or fish" shall be inserted after the words "any flesh,"
and the following words shall be added as a proviso to the said
sub-section:—

"Provided that no license shall be required for a place
used for selling or storing for sale of preserved flesh or fish
contained in air-tight and hermetically sealed receptacles."
