RIGHT HONORABLE SIR,

Paragraph 1. The accompanying papers will inform you of the measures taken by us for establishing a sanatorium for European Troops at a place called "Harris Valley" on the Gáli Parvatam range of hills in the District of Vizágapatám.

2. A Medical Committee was appointed by His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief to proceed to the above station and to report on its eligibility for a sanatorium. The result of their investigations is given in a report dated 24th February 1859, and considering the circumstances represented sufficiently promising to justify the small expense that would be occasioned by the measure, we resolved on sending up an experimental party of an officer and twenty Europeans with a Medical officer to reside in Harris Valley for a few months. The instructions issued by us for giving effect to this resolution will be found in our Proceedings in the Military Department dated 29th April and 15th August 1859 Nos. 1575 and 2910.

3. For further and more full particulars we beg to refer you to these papers and more especially to those recorded in our Proceedings in the Public Works Department dated 11th November 1859 No. 2634, which contain an interesting narrative furnished by Captain Blagrove, the District Engineer, of a visit paid by him in September last to the locality which has confirmed us in our opinion of the suitableness of the place for the purpose contemplated.
