No. 392. Read the following letter from Lieutenant-Colonel G. W. WALKER, R. E., Superintending Engineer, 7th Division, to Colonel C. A. ORR, R. E., Secretary to Government, Department Public Works, dated Coimbatore, 5th June 1865, No. 28:—

SIR,
1. A requisition having been made on this Office, by authority of His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief, for approximate estimates of the subsidiary Military buildings required at Wellington, according to the authorized list communicated with G. O. in the Military Department, No. 436 of 31st January 1865, to be included in the Budget of 1866-67, I have the honor to request that I may be supplied with copies of the latest approved Standard Plans of the buildings in question.

2. I have at the same time to observe that as one of the six Barrack Blocks remains unfinished, and the superstructure of the Military Prison has to be raised on the foundations, it is desirable that intimation be given of the order in which all the work should be undertaken, so that this Department may be able to state what can really be undertaken in each succeeding year.
