No. 370. Read the following letter from the Superintending Engineer, 4th Division, to the Secretary to Government, Public Works Department, dated Madras, 13th December 1866, No. 3,650:—

1 Survey.
1 Abstract Estimate.
3 Plans.

1. I have the honor to enclose, for the sanction of Government, an estimate amounting to Rupees 3,200, illustrated by a survey, for restoring the Champalli

and Agraharam channel in the Gudiatum Talook, Chittur Range, North Arcot District.

2. This project was matured at the request of the Collector of North Arcot, and its object is to furnish a supply of water to the Agraharam tank, on which, in consequence of the utterly inefficient condition of its supply channel, there has been a large annual loss of revenue to Government.

3. The present head of the Agraharam channel being in a very ruined state, and the ground through which it passes being difficult to work, the estimate provides for improving the Champalli channel, and connecting it by a new cut with the former.

4. The estimate has been countersigned by the Collector of North Arcot in token of approval, and the work is in progress out of special funds allotted by that Officer. The expenditure incurred out of special funds will be reported hereafter.

Referred to the Revenue Department, the work being in progress from *Famine Relief Funds*.
