Read the following:—

No. 214. From the Inspector-General of the Indian Medical Department, to the Chief Secretary to Government, Public Department, dated Fort St. George, 12th February 1870, No. 38.

In forwarding the enclosed letters from the Superintending Engineer, 4th Division, and the Medical Officer in charge of the hospital for women and children, Vepery, relative to the stoppage of the

improvements to that hospital under recent orders, I beg to express my regret at being under the necessity of troubling Government on the subject.

2. As, however, the Engineer says that the alterations in question cannot be completed without the special sanction of Government, while he states at the same time that a very trifling outlay would suffice to finish them, and thus to remedy the inconvenience pointed out by the Medical Officer, I have the honour to solicit that this sanction may, if possible, be accorded.
