No. 124. From Captain A. G. BEGBIE, R.E., Officiating Examiner of Public Works Accounts, to the Secretary to Government, Public Works Department, General Branch, dated Fort St. George, 11th September 1877, No. 100 W.

I HAVE the honor to invite the attention of Government to the correspondence marginally noted on the subject of the insufficiency of accommodation for this office, and to state that in consequence of the increased work imposed on this establishment by the famine relief accounts, it has become absolutely necessary to reopen the subject of additional accommodation, without which it is quite impossible for me to avail myself of the extra establishment sanctioned in G.O., No. 570, dated 11th August 1877, now requisite for the proper conduct of current work.

2. Any arrangement which would separate the office is manifestly open to objection; I have made inquiries of the Accountant-General, Madras, whose office adjoins mine, whether he can give me up any of his rooms, and he informs me that there is a large room adjoining the west verandah of this office, which is at present used by his Clerks as a tiffin-room, and a large portion of this he is willing to hand over to me provided it can be arranged that there shall be no means of communication between the two offices.

3. I understand that the room was condemned several years ago by the Public Works Department, but it appears to me that it would still answer the purpose required; and if there are no Engineering objections, I have the honor to request that the District Engineer, Presidency, may be instructed to provide the necessary partitions, putting the work *at once* in hand as an emergent work.

4. One of the windows opening on the verandah will require to be converted into a door; and the room being entirely enclosed by other buildings, and consequently an exceedingly hot one, punkahs will also be necessary.

5. Should however this arrangement be deemed impracticable, I am entirely at a loss for an alternative, unless the whole office can be moved bodily into larger and more suitable premises.

2. He will however bear in mind that the Examiner's Office will before long be removed to Chepauk and the additions and alterations are to be carried out as economically as possible.

BECOME ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY TO REOPEN THE SUBJECT OF AD-
DITIONAL ACCOMMODATION, WITHOUT WHICH IT IS QUITE IMPOSS-
IBLE FOR ME TO AVAIL MYSELF OF THE EXTRA ESTABLISHMENT
SANCTIONED IN G.O. NO. 570, DATED 11TH. AUGUST 1877 NOW RE-
QUISITE FOR THE PROPER CONDUCT OF CURRENT WORK.

2. ANY ARRANGEMENT WHICH WOULD SEPARATE THE OFFICE
IS MANIFESTLY OPEN TO OBJECTION; I HAVE MADE ENQUIRIES OF

THE ACCOUNTANT GENERAL, MADRAS, WHOSE OFFICE ADJOINS MINE
WHETHER HE CAN GIVE ME UP ANY OF HIS ROOMS, AND HE INFORMS
ME THAT THERE IS A LARGE ROOM ADJOINING THE WEST VERANDAH OF
THIS OFFICE, WHICH IS AT PRESENT USED BY HIS CLERKS AS A TIFF-
IN ROOM, AND A LARGE PORTION OF THIS HE IS WILLING TO HAND
OVER TO ME PROVIDED IT CAN BE ARRANGED THAT THERE SHALL BE
NO MEANS OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE TWO OFFICES.

3. I UNDERSTAND THAT THE ROOM WAS CONDEMNED SEVERAL
YEARS AGO BY THE P.W. DEPARTMENT BUT IT APPEARS TO ME THAT IT
WOULD STILL ANSWER THE PURPOSE REQUIRED; AND IF THERE ARE NO
ENGINEERING OBJECTIONS I HAVE THE HONOR TO REQUEST THAT THE
DISTRICT ENGINEER, PRESIDENCY, MAY BE INSTRUCTED TO PROVIDE *the*
NECESSARY PARTITIONS, PUTTING THE WORK AT ONCE IN HAND AS AN
EMERGENT WORK.

4. ONE OF THE WINDOWS OPENING ON THE VERANDAH WILL RE-
QUIRE TO BE CONVERTED INTO A DOOR; AND, THE ROOM BEING ENTIRE-
LY ENCLOSED BY OTHER BUILDINGS, AND CONSEQUENTLY AN EXCEEDINGLY
HOT ONE, FUNKANS WILL ALSO BE NECESSARY.

5. SHOULD HOWEVER THIS ARRANGEMENT BE DEEMED IMPRACTICA-
BLE, I AM ENTIRELY AT A LOSS FOR AN ALTERNATIVE, UNLESS THE
WHOLE OFFICE CAN BE MOVED BODILY INTO LARGER AND MORE SUIT-
ABLE PREMISES.
