I HAVE the honor to enclose copies of papers noted in the margin received from the Adjutant-General in reply to a reference made by this office regarding the regulations under which Sub-Conductor J. Smith has been granted two years' furlough to Europe, and to state that, in the absence of this information, this office is unable to prepare the necessary Last Pay Certificate.
