READ—the following letter from H. A. STUART, Esq., C.S., Superintendent of Census Operations, to the Secretary to Government, Revenue Department, dated Madras, 17th February 1891, No. 269 :—

I have the honor to forward, in original, a paper received from the Collector of Bellary, whose District Forest-officer apparently objects to paying postage due on census papers received by his range officers.

2. The amounts involved are trifling, and I should have thought that, in any case, they might have been defrayed without troubling the Government in the matter. If all such petty amounts were debited to census, a special auditing staff would be necessary, and this would probably cost more than the total of the charges. Moreover, if the principle advocated by Mr. Hooper is carried to its logical conclusion, the cost of every stamp affixed to a letter which did not relate solely to the business of his department should be borne not by the Forest budget but by some other.

3. As, however, the Collector of Bellary has thought proper to refer the matter, I have the honor to request that Government will be pleased to direct the payment of these small sums.
