I have the honor to report,
in reply to Board's Proceedings -
No. 522 of the 18th August last, that
the proposed improvements to the
Head Assistant Collector's office,
sketched by the Board in pencil
on the plan will cost only Rs 3000,
according to the executive Engineer's
rough estimate, and a Sub-Regis-
trar's office Rs 2360, making a
total of only Rs 5360, against
Rs 16,000, the approximate cost of
a new Head Assistant Collector's
Katcheri. The Head Assistant
Collector reports a considera-
ble sum will have to be spent
on

on his record room, as the roof is in possession of the white ants, but, even then, the difference in expense is very great; and, as the addition of the room suggested by the Board will meet all requirements sufficiently, it will be better to follow the cheaper course.

2. I have therefore, in accordance with para 5 of the Board's Proceedings under reply, returned the plan with the proposed improvement marked on it, to the Executive Engineer and requested him to prepare the necessary estimate.

The estimate under review amounting to Rs 2,360 provides for constructing a Sub Registrar's Office at Meris in the Trichinopoly District.

The estimate was called for in G.O. No 1144 of 16th January 1890 and has been framed on the Standard design circulated with G.O. No 1144 of 21st July 1888 except in the following respects.

- 1) The foundations are to be entirely of concrete.
- 2) The flooring is to be of Portland Cement Concrete 3" thick laid on 3" of brick pith with rammed.

The rate quoted in the estimate for tank work is Rs 4-0-0 against Rs 3-8-0 per cubic foot. The other rates are fair.
