Irrigation.

READ—the following paper:—

Telegram from the Superintending Engineer, II Circle, to the Chief Engineer for Irrigation, dated 8th August 1896.

Kistna slowly falling. Tammileru in flood. Please arrange for eight competent Upper Subordinates being sent here soon including Vijiaraghavalu, Ramanjam Pillai, Sergeant Brand. Three lakhs required under 42. Special repairs, urgent works, as follows: Raising and strengthening headworks both sides; river restoration and strengthening flood banks both above and below anicut, about one hundred miles total length; restoration of Bank canal from Kollur lock to end, if possible; restoration of Bandar and Ellore canals. My plan of action as follows: Employ permanent staff in restoring canals and making arrangements to save crops, local knowledge absolutely necessary for this. Employ men asked for on flood banks and headworks.

ORDER—No. 669 I., dated 12th August 1896.

The additional staff asked for by the Superintending Engineer, II Circle, will be arranged for by the Chief Engineer, Public Works Department.

2. The Superintending Engineer, II Circle, will submit, as soon as possible, a detailed report of the damages caused by the abnormal floods in the Kistna river.

3. The following deferred telegram will be sent:—

To the Secretary to the Government of India.

“Unprecedented floods in the Kistna river exceeding previously recorded maximum flood by more than one foot. Rs. 3,69,000 required under 42. (Working expenses) during current year for special repairs and urgent works as follows: Raising and strengthening headworks both sides: river restoration and strengthening flood banks both above and below aicut, about one hundred miles total length; restoration of Bank canal, western section, from Kollur lock to end, if possible; restoration of Bandar and Ellore canals. Please wire sanction.”
