Certificate and report from W. T. PIERCY, Esq., Assistant Accountant-General, to the Acting Under Secretary to Government, Pension department, dated Fort St. George, 12th July 1884, No. A.D.J.-139.

Certified that qualifying service in superior grade has been duly proved for 12 years 10 months and 28 days, and that a compensation gratuity, not exceeding Rs. 600, equal to 12 months' pay, is admissible under sections 104 and 113 (a) of the Civil Pension Code, 6th edition. The calculations have been duly verified. The particulars required by rules 1 and 6, under section 104 of the code, are given by the Collector in his remarks opposite to No. 4 in the 3rd page of the application.

2. In accordance with rule 4, under section 134, the attention of Government is respectfully solicited to section 69 of the code.

3. With reference to rule 3, section 103 of the Civil Pension Code, 6th edition, it is reported that the applicant's prospects of life are good.

ORDER—dated 5th August 1884, No. 731, Pension.

Under sections 104 and 113 (a) of the Civil Pension Code (6th edition), the Right Honorable the Governor in Council is pleased to grant to T. Gopal Nayadu, late head compositor, Madura District Press, a compensation gratuity of Rs. (600) six hundred, equal to twelve months' pay, payable at Madura, in consideration of his qualifying superior service of 12 years 10 months and 28 days.
