No. 11. Read the following *Extract from the Proceedings of the Board of Revenue*; dated 2d December 1856, No. 4030.

Read letter from the Acting Collector of Masulipatam, dated 14th November 1856,* stating with reference to the Board's Proceedings No. 3388 of 15th Ultimo, that the proposition to construct a building for the Civil Dispensary in the town of Masulipatam, should be adhered to, under the circumstances referred to.

Resolved that the foregoing letter be laid before Government, with reference to Extract Minutes Consultation dated 14th November, para. 5, No. 1217.

2. It will be seen that Mr. Bird did not in his decisions formally decree repayment of the amount exacted by the public servants to the parties from whom the sums had been received.

3. The Board request instructions as to whether the Acting Collector should at once carry the entire sum, recovered under Mr. Bird's judgments, to the credit of Government, or whether endeavours should still be made to discover the parties to whom repayments should be made with a view to their being paid the sums which may appear to be respectively due to them.

No. 12. ORDER THEREON, No. 84; dated 21st January 1857.

Under the circumstances represented, the Right Honorable the Governor in Council resolves to direct that the entire amount of fines collected from the Public servants of the District of Masulipatam be carried to the credit of Government. This should be done immediately.
