3. My reason for making this suggestion is that I consider that such an arrangement would be more advantageous in Public grounds than if the additional Sub Collector took charge of my duties.

4. Mr. Grant would, in all probability, be engaged with the annual settlement of the Palkhianah Jaghire and with matters connected with the Survey and reapeasement of the land at the time I wish to go away, and it would lead to inconvenience if he was obliged to give them up to attend to my duties while the Sub Collector who has entirely finished the Jamah bundy of his Division would be at liberty to carry on the additional work devolving upon the officer in charge of the District, during my absence.

5. I do not wish to leave until Mr. Puckle, who has been lately appointed to

to act as Head & Assistant, joins, which he will do, I believe, till about the 10th proximo.

6. I have communicated with Mr. Sub and the additional Sub Collectors on my proposition to give over charge of the District to the former, and they have both signified their approval of such an arrangement.
