Sir,
1. I deem it proper to state for the information of the Board, that I am unable to provide that European supervision of the Treasury transactions in this District that is expected under the Circular Orders on the subject; Mr. Master the only Assistant in this District being now summoned to Masulipatam for his examination, and his presence being required for some time in distant parts of the District both in the settlement of his own Talook, and also at the salt works at Chena Ganjam, while I am myself employed in the Jumnabund, which will keep me at a distance from Guntur for the best part of several months to come, if I remain unrelieved by Mr. Wood.

2. The Cash has been regularly subjected to the usual monthly examinations, but this season when large collections are coming in from the Talooks, it is impracticable to locate Mr. Master at Guntur to receive them into separate charge, and the only alternative is to allow much of the remittance to the General Treasury to be made upon the responsibility of the Cashkeeper without the constant supervision prescribed in the Circular

orders. It is impracticable to arrange otherwise without sacrificing the most important duties of the District, which with the want of the requisite assistance, are particularly pressing at the present period.

3. The Board are perhaps aware that as far back as May last, the Government held out to me the hope of being supplied with further assistance at an early date and I may be excused for bringing to notice here that since that time, 5 junior assistants have been appointed to other Districts, while this has been left with myself and only one assistant.
