were received by you thro'
the Government of India
from the supply transmitted
by this Government.

regret to state that there
are no ^{spare} copies of the Reports
on the Commerce of Madras
~~that can be spared from~~
~~their stores~~; and with respect
to the supply of the Madras
Selections, I am to observe
that the numbers printed
in 1854 were from 1 to 10, and
from 1855 up to this date
the numbers extend as far

as

as 41. It is therefore not
certain what Selections are
required by you. In
regard to "New Series 1, 11
4ea" which you wish should be
furnished, I am to state
that ^{new series} no of the Selections have
been published in this
Presidency and it is probably
those of the ^{Govt.} to which you refer. The
Government desire me to
state that should you
require any ^{of these} publications,
it will be better to make
your application to the
Government of India, to
whom a number of all
Selections are supplied
from each Presidency.
