CAUSES OF INCREASE AND DECREASE IN THE COLLECTIONS FOR NOVEMBER 1860, FASLI 1270.

LAND REVENUE, CURRENT.

Increase.

A—Attributed to the more punctual payment of kists.

B—Do. to the favorable character of the season.

C—Not explained.

Decrease.

D—Attributed to the introduction of the regular Kistbundy in the Amani Taluks.

LAND REVENUE, ARREARS.

Increase.

E—The kists of certain Taluks due in December were collected in November of last year, which was not the case in the present year.

F—Attributed to the want of punctuality in the collections.

G—Do. to the unfavorable character of the season.

H—Not explained.

Decrease.

J—Owing to the balance at the beginning of the Taluk having been large.

K—Do. to the outstanding balance at the beginning of Fasli having been small.

SUNDRY SOURCES OF REVENUE, CURRENT AND ARREARS.

Increase.

K—Chiefly in Salt owing to increased sales.

L—Do. in Abkarry owing to the inclusion of the Vellore Town Contracts in the accounts of this Fasli.

M—Chiefly in Salt, and Sea Customs and Sayer owing in the former case to the inclusion of the entire actual sales of the month in the accounts whereas hitherto only the amount remitted to the Huzur Treasury was so included and in the two latter cases to the increased rates of duty levied under the new Tariff respectively.

N—Chiefly in Salt owing to the rise in prices.

Decrease.

O—Chiefly in Salt owing to the diminished demand for Home and Inland consumption.

P—Owing to the operation of Act VII of 1859, in a portion of last Fasli.
