Honored Sir

The recent Memorial presented by me, containing a fuller and clearer explanation of the grounds of my claim to exemption from the annual payment of the sum of Star Pagodas 7278 now exacted in excess of the permanent Pesh cash of my Zemindari not having been forwarded for the orders of Her Majesty's Government, and feeling confident, from the nature of the case that a more favorable decision than has been awarded would be given, were the subject laid before the Right Honorable the Secretary of State in a clear and distinct manner, I respectfully beg to submit triplicate copies of another Memorial urging fresh grounds and solicit that you will be graciously pleased to procure orders for its transmission to that august Authority your honor will perceive that I chiefly plead as the ground of my claim to exemption of the extra payment the non possession of any lands whatever outside the ring fence of my Zemindari or of any other equivalent and that the exaction is therefore contrary to the express terms of my Summad and to the provisions of Reg. XXV of 1802. The truth of my statement can be easily ascertained
