SIR,

I have the honour to submit a report on the work of M. B. Ry. V. Ramaswami Aiyar M.A., Probationary Deputy Collector, Trichinopoly. He has been working throughout the first half of 1897 and is proving himself a reliable officer taking an interest in his work and bearing the best of characters. His physique is good and he is active in habits.

2. He was in Revenue charge of Trichinopoly Taluk from 17th January till 13th February 11th February till 18th March and from 25th March onwards, the intervals being occupied with Magisterial work and village accounts.

3. He was invested with 1st class powers on 10th April and since 11th May, has been in Magisterial charge of Trichinopoly Taluk. Previously to that since 9th February, he had Magisterial charge of Trichinopoly Cantonment.

4. During the Easter holidays, he accompanied me to Pudukottai and

assisted in my enquiry into dissensions among the Judges of that State.

5. As Probationary Deputy Magistrate, he disposed of 46 Criminal cases and, as Sub-Divisional Magistrate, 25 original cases, 5 Miscellaneous cases and 12 appeals, his judgments being carefully written and to the point.

6. He has several times checked the balance in the Huzur Treasury and been occasionally entrusted with currency chest transactions.

7. He is now doing all the duties of a Revenue Officer and finds his time fully occupied. He is doing the Jamedari of Pichinipoly Taluk.

8. In October last, he passed the Precis Writing Test and has lately appeared for examination in Riding and Telugu. When he came out with me to witness military field firing, he rode very creditably.

9. He made himself useful as Secretary for Famine Fund subscriptions and during the local celebration of the Diamond Jubilee.

I have the honour to report on the work and progress of Prob. Dy. Collector, Mr. R. R. Ramachandradurai awargal, during the half year ending on the 30th June last.

2. He went up in January for the Vernacular test and the riding test, and passed them.

3. On the 15th January he was given the Revenue Inspector's charge

of 22 villages in the Saidapet taluk,
and continued to do this work till
the 6th March.

4. From the 6th to the 30th March and
again for a few days in the end
of April he was on Circish in
my office and assisted in checking
the Jamabandi accounts. He was
also present with me while I
conducted the Jamabandi.

5. From the 31st March to the
16th April he was in charge of
the Saidapet Division (vide my office
letter of 31st March Ref no 799)

6. From the 5th May to the close of
the half year he was being
trained in Treasury work under
the Treasury Dy Collector.

7. Through out the half year

he attended to Magisterial work
also, and in February he was
invested with 2nd class powers.

8. He has acquired great experience
in Magisterial work, and a more
extended and practical knowledge
of revenue administration, and
I am well satisfied with his progress.
He is careful in whatever he does,
and promises to make a capable
and zealous officer.
