Sir,

I have the honor to report on the work of Mr. Wood, Probationary Deputy Collector attached to this District for the last half year.

2. Until the 2nd of April he was holding magisterial charge of the Head Quarter Deputy Collector's Division and since that date he has held full charge. He did the annual settlement of the Satyamangalam Taluk and part of that of the Bhavani Taluk. He disposed of 46 Calendar cases, 64 Criminal appeals, 17 miscellaneous cases and committed one case for trial.

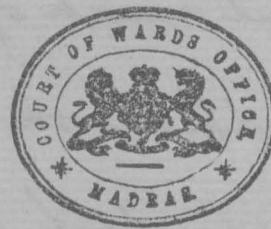
3. He has continued to work very steadily and well. He is slow about much of his work, but very hardworking, and his work is nearly always satisfactory. He finds his examinations difficult, especially Tamil which he speaks fluently, although he cannot read manuscript.
