SIR,

I have the honor to report that Mr. Woodhouse, Probationary Dy Collector, worked in this District during the whole of the half year ending 30th June 1897, with the exception of a few days in January last, when he went to Madras to appear for the Dy Collector's compulsory Vernacular Test.

Magisterial He exercised 3rd class powers till April last, when he was invested in the 2nd class powers. He presided over the Bench Court, Cocanada and tried several cases transferred to him from the Town Magistrate's file. His disposal was prompt and

and his decisions, fair.

Revenue.

He tried some suits under
act IV of 1895 & act VIII of 1865
and prepared office notes in appeals.

In the latter, he carefully dealt
with the law and rules on the subject.

Miscellaneous.

He was engaged at

Kattipudi, a Govt village in
the Peddapur Taluk, from 23rd January
to 7th February 1897, and subsequently

with the Kurnam of Jagannakpore
in the Cocanada Division, in
preparing the village accounts.

In March last, he was put in
charge of compensation work, in
my office, independently of the
Sheistadar, and supervised that
branch of work till he left this place

for Bhadrachalam in May last.

Like the Assistant Collector, he
opened my tappal, during my
absence and that of the Assistant,
Signed

signed fair copies and passed routine
drafts including orders on copy
applications and petitions. He was
also in charge of the duplicate keys
of the Currency Chest in the Bank. In
the early part of May he was sent
to the Bhadrachalam Taluk on famine
duty and is still there. His work there
is, on the whole, satisfactory.

He was to go to Waltair for survey
training in June last, but I could
not spare him.

The progress made by Mr. Woodhouse
is satisfactory. On account of his
absence in Bhadrachalam, the par-
ticulars of the Criminal & Revenue
cases tried by him are not available
at present. He is active & energetic
and tries to do his duty thoroughly.
