SIR,

I have the honor to furnish the usual report on the work of Mr Wood, Probationary Deputy Collector attached to this district, for the half year ending December 1896.

2. Mr Wood was in charge of the Coimbatore Division during the half year. At first he had only 2nd class powers, Mr Edgington was trying the original first class cases, and I disposed of the appeals. He received first class powers on the 23rd October 1896 and has been in full Magisterial charge since 2nd November.
3. He tried 9 criminal appeals, 32 calendar cases and 32 Miscellaneous

Cases during the half year.

4. He held charge of the Treasury from November 16th to December 2nd.

5. He had charge of the Revenue works of his Division until November 2nd when I placed Mr. Edgington in charge, in order to give him some experience of revenue work.

6. Mr. Wood is a steady plodding officer. His chief fault is want of activity, though I must admit that I have never known him fail to inspect any place which required inspection.
