SIR,

I have the honour to submit my report on the progress of Probationary Deputy Collector N. S. Somasundar Sastri during the half year ending 31st December 1896.

2. From the commencement of the half year up to November 9th, he was in charge of the Nagar Treasury at first under training, and subsequently in place of the permanent Treasury Deputy Collector, who was absent inspecting sub-treasuries. The usual certificate of competency to hold independent Treasury charge was granted in G.O. No. 5061 Misc. Dated 10th December 1896.

3. On being relieved of charge of the Treasury, Mr. N. S. Somasundar Sastri was entrusted with the usual duties of a personal assistant to the Collector.

posing of certain specified papers made over to him,
and carrying out such other routine duties as was convenient.
In addition three criminal cases and nine summary
suits were made over to him for trial. Two of the former
were disposed of. The other criminal case and all the
suits are still pending, part heard. There has been no
unjustifiable delay, the witnesses not having attended when
required.

4. Mr. R. V. S. Soma Sundar Sastri entered for the
Revenue Test, Higher and Account Test, Higher, at the
Examination in October 1896. The results have not been
published.

5. He has made satisfactory progress in every way,
and should be secure a pass in the Special Tests just
mentioned. I recommend that he may be confirmed as
Deputy Collector.

SIR,

I have the honour to report on
the progress made by Probationary
Deputy Collector Mr. R. V. Ramasami
Aiyar over job during the half year
ending 31st December 1896.

2. In July and August he was being
trained in Treasury work and has been
declared fit to be in independent charge
of a Treasury. He was sent out for a
few days in August to inspect the da-
mage done by the floods. From 18th Sept.
to 14th October he was in charge of the office
of Deputy Tahsildar and Sub-Magistrate,
Kilapalan and exercised 2nd class ma-
gisterial powers. He has since been
trying magisterial Cases, about 8 in
a week, transferred to his file. He could
not be put in charge of a village
as since he returned from Kilapalan

His presence has been necessary at
 head-quarters to make daily transfers
 to the Currency Chest as required by
 the Accountant-General. He has also
 been studying office routine and
 the disposal number system. He has
 thus been engaged in ~~useful~~ work
 throughout the half year. In October
 he appeared for the Criminal Higher
 Account Test and Precise writing
 Test. The result is not yet published,
 but it is known that he failed in
 Criminal Higher. I consider the progress
 he has made to be satisfactory.
