In the B.R. disposed of in
G.O. of 17th December 1896 No 5211 the
the Board recommended the
confirmation of Dy Collectors L.
Nanumantha Rao, K.S. Soma-
Sundara Sastri & P. Smaishwami
Aiyangar. The confirmation of
the last two officers was deferred
pending receipt of the report called
for in B.R. No 211 of 9 December '96
as to why they did not pass
all the special tests within their
probationary period. The Board
now submits the explanation
of the Dy Collectors and reports
that they have since passed all
the tests. The Dy Collectors urge
that having been appointed in
November 1894 they had only two
opportunities of passing the former test
viz in October 1895 & in October 1896
and that they had to appear for

some tests in 1895 & for the rest
in 1896 as it was a difficult matter
for them to pass all the form tests
in one year. The collectors concerned
recommended this confirmation.

In accordance with my instructions
I submit the D's who may
be confirmed as they have
in fact satisfied the conditions
of their appt.
