Proceedings of the Board of Revenue (Land Revenue).

No.193 Miscellaneous/Conf1.No.10,Forest
Dated 20th March 1899.

Read again Board's Proceedings Forest No.80 Misc./
Conf1.No.4,dated 9th February 1899,communicating to the Collector
of Malabar and the Conservator of Forests,Southern Circle,autho-
rising the former officer to negotiate for the purchase of block
No.4 in the Attapadi valley.

Read also the following letter from G.W.Dance Esq.,
Collector of Malabar,to the Secretary to the Commissioners of ---
Land Revenue,Madras,Ref.on C.No.7-Conf1.,dated 13th March 1899:--

In reply to Board's Proceedings dated 9th February
1899 Forest No.80 Misc.,dated Confidential No.4,I have the honor
to state that I have had two interviews with the Mannarghat Nayar.
He refuses to part with Block IV for less than a lakh of Rupees.I
informed him that ~~xxx~~ this would effectually close negotiations.-
He tells me however that two Coonoor planters,Messrs.Davidson and
Vernede,are forming a syndicate in London for the purpose of ---
taking up this land for coffee at £ 1 an acre.The District Forest
Officer thinks that this alleged agreement is merely intended to
force Government to offer a higher price,and I am inclined to ag-
agree with him.Anyhow the Nayar will not accept one Rupee an acre
or anything near it.

Resolution

Recorded with the remark that the Board agrees ---

with the Collector in considering the Nayar's demands to be grossly in excess of the value of the land. The negotiations may be dropped for the present.
