Resolution

The Board submits to Government the revised confidential Register of persons qualified for the post of Deputy Collector, printed with reference to the orders of Government in para 2 (1) of G.O.No.282 Revenue, dated 18th May 1898. Bound copy will be submitted later on.

2. As regards officers employed in Departments other than Land Revenue the Board has, in accordance with the instructions of Government, excluded from the Register the names of all persons who have not been specially recommended for the appointment of Dy. Collector by the Head of the Department concerned. In future the Board proposes to obtain reports on the subject direct from the Heads of Departments instead of through Collectors.

3. Alterations reported by Collectors while the lists relating to their districts were passing through the Press have been incorporated as far as possible in the printed Register, and where this was not possible, the necessary entries have been made in manuscript.

4. Five copies of the list relating to each district are forwarded to the Collectors concerned for record in their offices. Any alterations that may be found necessary in the lists as regards appointments held by the officers, &c. may be included in the list of alterations to be submitted next year.
