In reply to your letter No. Mis: No. 1056-A
Confid: No. 31-A dated the 13th March last, asking for
information as to the nature and extent of any property
owned by Mr. F. D. Meppen in the Mysore State, I have the
honor to forward a copy of a report dated the 7th ultimo,
from the Amildar of Chickmagalur, furnishing particulars
as to Mr. Meppen's property in the Kadur district. It is
reported that Mr. Meppen owns no property in any of the
other districts of Mysore.

Chickmagalur Amildar's report dated 7th April 1899.

Mr.F.D.Meppen is said to have once owned the Harobidikal Estate and a portion of the Yemmedoddi Estate, but he has no interest in them now. The only estate in which he has any interest at present is that of Attigiri. One Batni Gopaul Rao of Shimoga had 2/3rd share in that estate. He sold his share to Mr.F.D Meppen for Rs.50000/- on the 2nd May 1895, and executed a conveyance on that date and got it registered. Mr Meppen paid only Rs.5000/- towards the consideration and the balance due to Gopaul Rao does not seem to have been paid to him or to his creditors subsequently. This share in the estate comprises the following lands.

They are almost uncultivated. They are said to have been before their sale to Mr.Meppen, mortgaged by Gopaul Rao to one Rukmibai (widow of Batni Kreshna Rao) for a debt of about Rs.35,000/- She got them attached and lately sold for her dues under the orders of the District Judge of Shimoga and having purchased them herself in

the auction sale, applied for the possession thereof.

Mr. J. W. Meppon, son of Mr. F. D. Meppon, is objecting to her taking possession of the lands in question. With those encumbrances Mr. F. D. Meppon is supposed to be the purchaser of these lands and I believe this is the estate referred to in the letter of the First Assistant to the Resident.
