READ—again Proceedings of the Board of Revenue (Land Revenue), Mis No. 3368, dated 8th September 1897.

ABSTRACT.—Recording, pending receipt of the returns from Collectors and Conservators of Forests, Accountant-General's statement of Gazetted officers who have attained the age of 55 years or who will attain that age during the official year 1898-99; requesting Collectors and Conservators to submit the statements due by them not later than the 15th November of each year; and forwarding to the Secretary to the Commissioner of Separate Revenue an extract from the Accountant-General's statement relating to Mr. C. Kiernander, Head Appraiser, Sea Customs, Madras.

READ—also statements received from Collectors and Conservators of Forests showing the names of Gazetted officers who have attained the age of 55 years or who will attain that age during the official year 1898-99.

RESOLUTION—No. 419, dated 30th November 1897.

With reference to paragraph 2 of Government Order, No. 801, Revenue, dated 6th December 1895, the Board submits to Government the accompanying statement of Gazetted officers who have attained the age of 55 years or who will attain that age during the official year 1898-99.

2. Returns are still due from the Collectors of Bellary and North Arcot, but the Board believes that there are no officers in these districts who will attain the age of 55 during 1898-99.
