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## SUBJECT.

READ lists received from Collectors for 1897-98 of alterations to be made in the Confidential Register of persons qualified for the post of Deputy-Collector.

Resolution

In Government Order, No 282, Revenue, dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1898, Government passed orders on certain changes proposed by Mr. W. S. Meyer I.C.S. in regard to the submission of annual lists of persons qualified for the post of Deputy collector. The changes approved by Government are that in lieu of the two lists now submitted to Government, viz:-

- A (1) a list of all persons qualified by examination for the post of Deputy collector,
- B (2) a list of persons recommended for that appointment,

there should be submitted a single list of all



all qualified persons in the Land Revenue Department drawing salaries of Rupees 150 or upwards, and of persons on similar pay in other Departments of Government, who have been specially recommended by the Heads of their departments.

2. A Register of such officers will be printed shortly, and extracts therefrom will be communicated to collectors and other officers concerned. This Register will take the place of the present printed Register, and any alterations required therein will be reported to Government every year on information obtained from collectors as well as from the Heads of Offices in the Presidency Town.

3. As the lists for 1897-98 are now overdue the Board resolves to report to Government the items to be omitted from the present Confidential Register in pursuance of the orders of Government referred to above. These items are indicated by Numbers in Appendix A accompanying.

4. A list of the alterations to be made for 1897-98 as regards the names to be retained in the Register is also submitted as Appendix B.

5. The delay in the submission of the Board's lists is due chiefly to the late receipt of the reports from North Arcot and Cuddapah. The report from Cuddapah was received on the 23<sup>rd</sup> May, and that from North Arcot on the 25<sup>th</sup> idem.
