I have thus completed all the tests required for a post of Deputy Collector & have been working in Government service from the middle of 1882 & throughout have worked satisfactorily, hard & with honesty. I have been working as Tahsildar for a sufficiently long period & am also confirmed in that grade. I am a descendant of a high, ancient & respected Mahomedan family, connected with the family of Tabob Chunda Yakeb. My ancestors were held in great estimation by Sir Arthur Wellesley & other officers of his time as may be seen from my petition for a post of Deputy Collector submitted through Charles Haugh Esquire, late Collector of this District, with his recommendation in his following endorsement N^o 97 dated 16-1-93.

2. He has worked well as a Deputy Tahsildar & sub-magistrate. It seems very desirable to encourage men of his persuasion who educate themselves up to official requirements."

5. In G. O. No 415 dated 31-1-93, the con- sideration of my claims for a post of Deputy Collector was deferred because I was not a permanent Tahsildar. And now as I am a permanent Tahsildar & am long-standing in Govt service & in expectation of being selected as a Deputy Collector, I beg you to look into my case & support me.

6. For this gracious conduct I shall always remember you with every gratitude.

2. The petitioner is the permanent Tahsildar of Sirsadda on 150 Rs with a high reputation for honesty, conscientiousness and painstaking. But his educational attainments are poor as evidenced by his reports and magistrate judgments which are unnecessarily lengthy, generally and sometimes ungrammatical or unintelligible.

In the G.O. marked I, an application from Muhammad Bahauddin Sahib, Tahsildar of Cumbrum, for a Deputy Collector's appointment was rejected under Para 5 of the C. Petn. rules. He now submits his application formally through the Collector of Kurnool.

2. Bahauddin Sahib has been constantly addressing Govt ever since June 1893 and he has been told more than once that he must wait until he was a confirmed Tahsildar before his claims could even be considered. He has since been confirmed as a Tahsildar but the Acting Collector in forwarding his present application remarks that though he is an

with a high reputation for honesty, conscientiousness and painstaking, "his educational attainments are poor as evidenced by his reports and magisterial judgments which are unnecessarily lengthy generally and sometimes ungrammatical or unintelligible". In the Confidential register recently submitted by the Board, the Collector has not recommended Bahavudin Sahib's appointment as a Deputy Collector but merely remarks "Honest and steady, but his educational attainments are poor; cannot write intelligent reports".

3 It may also be men-

tioned here that even among Muhammadan officers there are some who have already been actually recommended for appointment as Deputy Collectors and whose claims are therefore ^{apparently} to be considered superior to those of Bahavudin Sahib. Orders are in these circumstances solicited as to what reply

reply should now be given to him.
