I have the honour to submit the following report on the progress of Mr. R. R. Kodayanallur Venkatarama Srinivasa Aiyangar during the half year ending 30th June 1898.

At the end of 1897 as I reported in my letter dated 28th January 1898 No. 4 Confidential, Mr. Srinivasa Aiyangar was at Kendapalle where he remained until the 17th January disposing of cases and suits which remained on his file at the end of December. Having finished them he came in to Head-Quarters and was placed under the Treasury deputy collector for Treasury training on the 29th January. With a break from the 23rd March

March to the 18th April when he accompanied me for the jamabandi of Tenali Taluk, he remained under training till the 5th June. He has obtained a certificate that he is competent & has been declared by the Government to be qualified to hold independent charge of a Treasury (G. O. dated 22nd June 98 N. 2656 mis). After a short period on general duty in my office during which he had the opportunity of studying Revenue papers and my orders on matters that arose he was placed on the 13th June in independent charge of the Avanigadda Deputy Tahsildar's division, so far as Revenue work is concerned. I have also arranged to transfer to him a certain number of third class Magisterial cases. He has not yet disposed of any during the short period in question.

3. I regret to say that the results of the last October special test examinations, which were received during the

half year, show him to have failed. I hope he will pass next October, as he has within the making of a very good officer. And I would like to see him confirmed in the service. He has shown plenty of intelligence & sense in the drafts and papers of his I have seen. He passed the riding and vernacular tests in Madras in January.

4. He owns a horse and rides well.
