READ letter from Mr. Young Esq., Acting Collector of the Chingleput District, to the Secretary to the Government of Land Revenue, dated 17th July 1898, No. 1711.

I have the honor to report on the progress made by Probationary Deputy Collector Mr. R. A. Ramacha Nodungari, during the half year ending June 30th last.

2. From 1st to 31st January he was on privilege leave. From 1st February until 9th March, he was in charge of the Hydrabad Treasury during the absence of Mr. R. P. S. Gopalapathi Niyar on other duty. From March 9th till April 24th he attended to the routine work in the Collector's office, accompanied the Collector on tour during Jambhanti and helped to check village accounts &c. From 25th April to June 30th he was in Revenue charge of the Saidapet division.

3. He exercised 2nd Class Magisterial powers from 13th April to 30th June. Mr. Robertson informs

me that his Magisterial work was good and thorough, and I am also of the same opinion.

4. I may say that both Mr Murdoch and Mr Robertson were well satisfied with him and considered him a hard working and zealous officer. He has given me the same impression during the short time I have been in the district.

5. He has lately been invested with 1st Class Magisterial powers and is now in charge of the Sub-Division owing to M R R Krishna Rao Awarab having been suddenly obliged to take privilege leave. He is doing well.
