the following letter from A. E. Lucin-
pet, Veterinary Colonel, Inspector
General, Civil Veterinary Department,
No 1011-219. m. dated 15th July 98: —

x x x x x x x x x x.

5. I would add, for the in-
formation of His Excellency the
Governor in Council, that Veterinary
Lieutenant Edwards has been
frequently asked, when in doubt,
to write either to me or to the
Assistant to the Inspector-General,
Civil Veterinary Department,
who is in charge of the cattle
section of my office: he has there-
no excuse. This failure, coupled
with the Board of Revenue's re-
marks on his Annual report
1897-98 (vide Board Proceedings

and 2nd June 1898) lead me to fear that Veterinary Lieutenant Edwards will not prove an officer in any way calculated for service in the Civil Veterinary Department, in which, owing to our small numbers, every officer should be energetic, and should possess great powers of organization and scientific attainments.

6. Under the circumstances, I would solicit the favor of your opinion, whether it would not be advisable to ask Veterinary Lieutenant Edwards to revert to military duty, as soon as I am in a position to appoint an officer who would be more likely to suit the appointment in the Madras Presidency.

Resolution.

With respect to para 6 of the Inspector General's letter, the Board is not prepared to oppose his opinion that Veterinary Lieutenant Edwards should revert to military duty.
