SIR,

In reply to reference no 874, dated 6th instant forwarding G. O. Misc: 3161 Rev: dated 28th July, last, asking whether there is any objection to M. R. Ry. A. Ramacha Nedungadi's being confirmed as a Deputy Collector, I have the honor to state that so far as I am aware there exists no objection.

2. I only joined the District on the 3rd instant and am therefore not in a position to express an opinion that ^{would} be of any value of the qualifications

of the officer named, but I find that Messrs Murdoch, Robertson and Young my predecessors, have all recorded favorable opinions of him. Mr Murdoch had of course seen a great deal of him and his work.

3. I may perhaps remind the Board that Mr. R. By A. Ramacha Nedungadi has only recently been invested with first class Magisterial powers and has as yet tried no Criminal appeals.

the following conditions, viz
(i) that "he should pass the
"vernacular and other tests
"prescribed for the post of Dep^y
"Collector before the expiration of
"the probationary period" and
(ii) that his confirmation would
"depend" on his giving satis-
"faction in the performance of
"his duties during the term of
"probation"

He joined his appointment on the
11th of July 1896 and his pro-
bationary period therefore expires
on the 11th ultimo. He passed all
the prescribed tests within the
above period and in the half

early reports submitted to Govt. his work was also favourably noticed by the Collector (of Chingleput) under whom he has been serving. The Board of Rev. was, in these circumstances, asked, in G.O. misc no. 3161 Rev. C of 28. VII. 98, to report whether there was any objection to his being confirmed as a Deputy Collector.

2. The Board now reports in consultation with Mr Cowie, the Asst Collector of Chingleput, that "it sees no objection to the confirmation of the officer in question. Mr Cowie being new to the district expressed his inability to bear any personal testimony to Ramachan Nedungadi's qualifications but states that Messrs Murdoch, Robertson and Young have all recorded favourable opinions of him. Mr Cowie also adds that Ramachan Nedungadi having but been recently invested with magisterial powers "has as yet tried

3. The reports on the work of Ramachan Nedungadi will be found stitched into the marginally noted G.O. and as already indicated above they are all favourable to him. The conditions under which he was originally appointed have thus been fulfilled and the question of his confirmation is therefore submitted for orders. It may be mentioned here that the question (suggested in the Asst Collector's letter) whether an officer's confirmation should be postponed pending the exercise by him of 1st Class powers for a sufficiently long time does not appear to have ever before been raised.
