READ—again the following paper:—

G.O., No. 692, Political, dated 29th September 1898.

ABSTRACT.—Recording an endorsement from the Government of India forwarding copy of a letter addressed by that Government to the Agent to the Governor-General at Baroda regarding the transfer to His Highness the Gaekwar of Baroda of the Seager property at Ootacamund and the purchase by His Highness of survey Nos. A-62 and A-121 adjoining that estate.

READ—also the following paper:—

From A. BUTTERWORTH, Esq., I.C.S., Acting Collector of the Nilgiris, to the Chief Secretary to Government, dated Ootacamund, 1st November 1898, R. Dis. No. 502 of 1898.

In continuation of this office letter, dated 29th April 1898, Ref. on Confidential No. 3 of 1898, I have the honour to report that the Gaekwar of Baroda State has purchased the following fields in Ootacamund from Mr. Allan, and that the conveyance is dated the 22nd August 1898 and was registered on the same day:—

2. The "Blue Gum Plantations" property consisting of survey Nos. A-120A and A-122 (area 38.82 acres), permission for the purchase of which was refused by the Government of India (*vide* G.O., No. 692, Political, dated 29th September 1898), was actually purchased on behalf of the Gaekwar on the 21st April 1898 for Rs. 18,000. The conveyance was executed by Elizabeth Withers as administratrix of the estate of the late Mrs. Seager.
