READ the following letter from H. C. D. Harding Esq.,
Acting Collector of Cuddapah, to the Secretary to the
Commissioners of Land Revenue, dated 17 January 1899,
Dis: No 2, Confidential.

With reference to the Board's Pro-
ceedings, No 126, Conf, dated 27th May 1898, I have the honor
to report that excepting Deputy Collector Aikhesavulu
Nayudu of Jamunamadugu, there are no persons in this
District whose transfer I particularly desire. Nothing
special has transpired against any body to lead me to
form any definite opinions. Pompapathi Sastri is
gone and Muhammad Jaffir Ansam reduced from
Sub. Magistrate of Kamalapuram to a Head Account-
antship. There are others of whom my predecessors have
recorded such remarks as "dishonest I fear" but that is
too vague to lead me to wish for or hope for good from
transfers.

As regards Aikhesavulu Nayudu, Pompapathi
Sastri was always held to be a bad man - and Aikhesavulu
is

is ranked with him by the people. They all say in Jamnala-
madang that what the Tahsildar said was sure to be
done by the Deputy collector. His conduct was very
suspicious in some big rioting cases of Proddatur.
Rumour has it that he took Rs 2000 from one side,
but it is merely rumour. He sometimes takes a
suspiciously long time between hearing an appeal and
writing judgment. His face does not strike me as looking
trustworthy - and rumour says it does not betray him.
That is all I can say against him, but it is sufficient
to make me wish for his transfer.

Resolution.

As the collector's letter relates to the
transfer of a Deputy collector it will be submitted to
Government for disposal.

2. The Board has no special know-
ledge of the conduct or character of the officer referred
to.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF REVENUE (LAND REVENUE).

RESOLUTION—No. 126 (Confdl. No. 32), dated 27th May 1898.

All Collectors are requested to submit lists of officials who in their opinion
should be transferred to some other district. The lists should include officers of
and above the grade of Deputy Tahsildar and should be accompanied by a brief
record of the reasons necessitating a transfer in each case. A timely transfer may
often enable a man who has incurred suspicion in one district to make a fresh start
elsewhere, and to be thus saved from going from bad to worse.

2. The return should be considered to be strictly confidential and should
be revised from time to time as occasion may require. Fresh returns should be
submitted on the 15th January of each year.
