

After the appeal was disposed of as above, it appears that upon a careful perusal of the appellant's letter, it was directed by Judge C. C. Wells at St. Louis to send the Papers in the case which had been returned with the original of the Karamuna of 1862, when referred to. These Papers were furnished by the State with his signature of 22nd March 1864, 22/3/64 with the receipt of the original Karamuna which was not forthcoming with 22nd July 1864. The State further had a Detention from the appellant's letter of the party who I agree to the joint registration of the appellant's & his departure on the subject.

Accordingly, in conformity with an official Detention, further being to come from St. Louis 22nd July 1864, the joint registration of the appellant with him, the letter was directed to come under 22nd July 1864. But he offered to prove the letter that he was under the authority of the Detention - this, as well as another letter of 22nd July 1864 further objected to each / joint registration. See also's charges of 22nd June 1864.

I think therefore that the original Detachment forwarded with reference to the above Charge, as paid by John Blair, which was kept back pending the further Enquiries may now be sent to the Appellants as desired.
