Deputy Collector's opinion and recommendation

Chopant was a madman sent by order of Government to the Lunatic Asylum at Bangalore in 1879 as being really insane & afterwards found to be sane & released. The law which was abolished in 1870.

This is also Council of the 17th Decr for Palawan and various islands including 10 per cent for the studies of science and agriculture of the island as per Circular Order No. 188.

The lands belonging to the Sultan & others who were willing to pay the assessment on their lands to the British.
