The man's own lands shown in Col. 6 and covered by Title Deed No. 127 were granted for specific performances of (1) daily worship of Chockalingaswami (2) Jannu paya and (3) Madamswami in the Parangudi Nayana Taluk in the Sankara-namahal village. The lands were alienated by outright sale, twenty years ago by the heir of the original holder and the prescribed services were no longer performed. Consequently the man's own lands were resumed by Government in their order no. 2722 Rev. dated 7th September 1911 and a new title deed identical in conditions with the old one was offered to any one who would undertake (1) and (2) the persons who are now in actual possession of the lands and (3) to perform the services for which the man has granted. Ramaswami Kusumahal refers to in Col. 12 having accepted the offer, Government have, in their order no. 1077, dated 10th April 1912, assigned the man's own lands to him and have directed the issue to him of a title deed identical in conditions with the cancelled one. Hence the fresh man register.

File correspondence ending with Collection letter No. 2396-B-1 of 12/2/1912 and 1912 was confirmed as recommended. It was recommended by the Taluk Commissionary on 19/7/1912.
