Memo explaining the circumstances under which the temple poramboke land S.No. 482 in Kuttalam village, -- Tenkasi taluk, was ordered to be settled as inam.

S.No. 482 measuring 27.67 acres in Kuttalam village Tenkasi taluk, was registered as temple poramboke. There is a large siva temple on it under the management of the District Siva Committee and trustees. There are also -- certain madams and other buildings in the same survey --- field. In the course of ^{an} enquiry instituted regarding an encroachment, several other encroachments and alienations of the portions of the land by the temple authorities were noticed. On a report made in Collector's R.Dis.No. 250/Ver. 1905 dated 13-10-05 and R.Dis. No. 75/Ver.1907 dated 30-3-1907 recommending the resumption of the lands on the ground that, having been set apart for temple ---- purposes, they had been diverted to purposes other than those connected with the temple service or worship, the Board in its B.P.No. 169.L.R. dated 15-6-1907 ordered that (1) the portions of the field S.No. 482 which are held by ~~the~~ persons unconnected with the temple should be sub-divided and charged the appropriate taram assessment. (2) that the remaining portions exclusive of the sites of the temple buildings and tank, but inclusive of the various plots of land which are in the enjoyment of the temple or its servants or from which the temple derives benefit, should be subdivided and settled ----- separately as inam, subject to express definite ----- conditions in each case, defining the service to be -- maintained and (3) that the sites of the temple and its appertunances should remain as poramboke.
