

**DESCRIPTIVE MEMOIR OF TATTANKULAM OF THE
NANGUNERI TALUQ.**

Situation. This village is situated eight miles east of Nanguneri.
Area. The areas given below have been merged in this village by Settlement.

The area prior to Settlement was, omitting fractions, 366 acres; by Settlement, it is 413 acres; net increase by Settlement 47 acres.

It must be distinctly borne in mind that a deduction of 10 per cent. has been made in calculating the rates of assessment on all fields wet or dry, on account of any roads, channels, paths, banks, &c., that may have been measured in with the cultivated area. The fact of the inclusion, therefore, of any such Government poramboke, in any Survey field, does not confer on the cultivator of that field the right of entering on such poramboke, or of in any way interfering with it, and any unauthorized encroachment on it will be severely punished.

Demarcation. This village, as now formed by Settlement, contains 2 mandams or sub-divisions, and 35 Survey fields.

The demarcation marks erected are:—

Irrigation. This village is irrigated by a rain-fed tank. The situation and irrigation are both indifferent. This village has accordingly been placed in third group.

And Karamat. The ryots have undertaken to keep the sluices clear of silt, to erect ring bunds in front of breaches, and to clear the distributing channels, when needed, at their own cost, as per separate statement.

Settlement. The entire area under Tattankulam, a rain-fed tank, is assessed in Class V. The lands supplied by Government wells are assessed in Class III, dry. The dry lands are assessed in Class IX.

Deducting fixed remissions only, the net average of the land assessment for the past five to years is Rupees 230; by Settlement it is Rupees 157; total reduction Rupees 73. The former wet land assessment was calculated on the village average (Mottasaraari) which was Rupees 12-2-11 an acre for a single crop (Peshanam), and Rupees 12-10-10 an acre for a second crop (Kar). The former commutation rate was Rupees 3-1-0 per grain octah of five bush for both Peshanam and Kar paddy.

The dry lands were held at five annas, five pice an acre, subject to a remission of one anna, three pice an acre as Chaurbagam, and of three pice an acre as Stalamkaval.

Paluyas. 785 trees paid an assessment of Rupees 17 in Fasl 1285.

Besides these, there are 837 growing seedlings that have hitherto paid no assessment. The charge for palmyras growing on patah lands and owned by the land-holders, has now been fixed at Rupees 11-5-0 per annum. The remaining trees on patah lands, owned by others than the land-holders, as well as all trees on Government waste, &c. are now chargeable at one anna each for Paravani, six pice each for Kattu and Kai, and three pice each for Olavatu. The seedlings on such lands will be charged for as they come to maturity. Such fields as are now free from tree-tax, will be free from charge for trees grown during the term of the present Settlement.

Palmyras are not to be planted on, or within, the bank of any irrigating work belonging to Government without the Collector's permission, and should the Collector think fit to cut the trees growing on tank or channel banks, or on any other description of Government waste land, no claim for compensation on the part of the persons at present using such trees on payment of an annual tree-tax will be attended to, but the assessment of all trees so cut will be deducted from the tree patahs.

No lands have been specially set aside for this purpose; the cattle are fed on the patah lands and Government waste.

Is sufficient for present requirements.

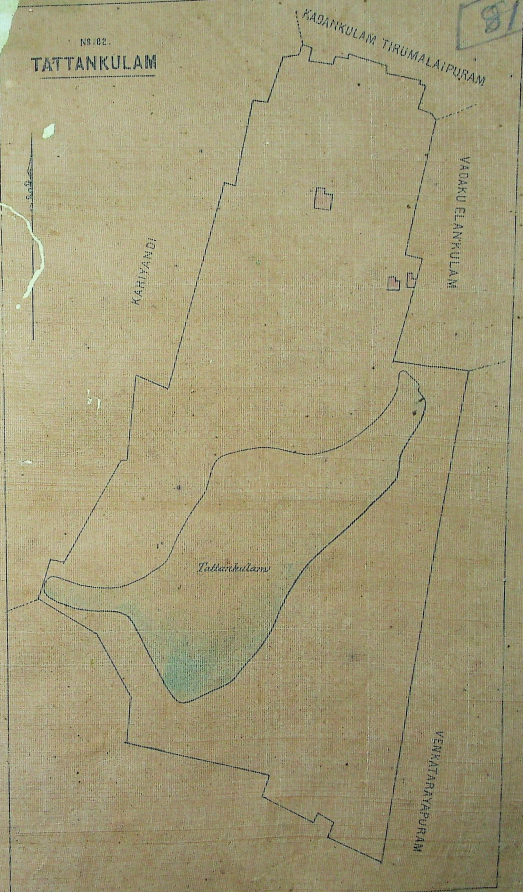
No patah will be granted for cultivation within the limits of the Paddling and no new enclosure is to be made or new building erected without permission in future.

The Chaturbaram and Stalamkaval deductions, amounting to Rupees 14- and Rupees 2-14-4 respectively, have been resumed.
