DESCRIPTIVE MEMOIR OF TORANAKURICHI OF THE
NANGUNERI TALUQ.

Situation. This village, the twenty-fifth under the irrigation of the Nanguneri-
yan channel, is situated two miles south of Nanguneri on road No. V, Palamcottah to Travancore.

Area. The boundary of this village remains unchanged by Settlement.

The area prior to Settlement was, omitting fractions, 196 acres; by Settlement it is 225 acres; not increase by Settlement 29 acres.

It must be distinctly borne in mind that a deduction of 10 per cent. has been made in calculating the rates of assessment, on all fields, wet or dry, on account of any roads, channels, paths, tanks, &c., that may have been measured in with the cultivated area. The fact of the inclusion, therefore, of any such Government poramboke in any Survey field, does not confer on the cultivator of that field the right of entering on such poramboke, or in any way interfering with it, and any unauthorized encroachment on it will be severely punished.

Demarcation. This village, as now formed by Settlement, contains one Kandam or sub-division and 27 Survey fields. The demarcation marks erected and standing are:—

These have all been inspected and the field stones have been sunk to the level of the ground. The village officers have given receipts for them, and are now responsible for their upkeep.

Irrigation. This village is irrigated by a tank supplied by the Vellattotai channel a branch of the Nanguneriyan channel. The situation and irrigation are both indifferent. This village has accordingly been placed in the third group.

Land Revenue. The ryots have undertaken to keep the sluices clear of silt, to erect ring bunds in front of branches, and to clear the distributing channels when needed, at their own cost, as per separate statement.

Settlement. The entire irrigated area of this village is assessed in class V. The lands supplied by taking are assessed at half the nanjah rate of the village. The dry lands are all assessed in class IX.

The following table exhibits the revised assessment of the village. No lands have been compounded for as permanent double crop.

Deducting fixed assessments only, the net average of 111 land assessment for the year 1285 is Rupees 264, for Settlement 1285 Rupees 264, 1286 Rupees 264, 1287 Rupees 264. The former wet land assessment was established on the village average (Mettanur) which was Rupees 215.10 an average single crop (rice) and Rupees 100 an acre for a second crop (rice). The former permanent rate was Rupees 12.15 per acre of rice and the rate for the second crop was 12.15 per acre.

The dry lands were held as four acres, eight acres or more, subject to a remission of one acre right per acre as Settlement and 1 acre more per acre as Chaturbaram.

Palayam. 10.84 acres paid an assessment of Rupees 37 in Fasil 1285. These were classed as under:—

Besides these, there are 207 growing seedlings that have hitherto paid no assessment. The charge for palms growing on pattah lands and owned by the land-holders, has now been fixed at Rupees 2-14-0 per annum. The remaining trees on pattah lands owned by others than the land-holders, as well as all trees on Government waste, &c., are now chargeable at one anna each for Paruvam, six pice each for Kattu and Kai, and three pice each for Olavethu. The seedlings on such lands will be charged for as they come to maturity. Such fields as are now free from tree tax, will be free from all charge for trees grown during the term of the present Settlement.

Fruit-trees are not to be planted on, or within, the bank of any irrigation work belonging to Government without the Collector's permission, and should the Collector think fit to cut the trees now growing on tank or channel banks, or on any other description of Government waste land, no claim for compensation on the part of the persons at present using such trees on payment of an annual tree-tax will be attended to, but the assessment of all trees so cut will be deducted from the tree pattahs.

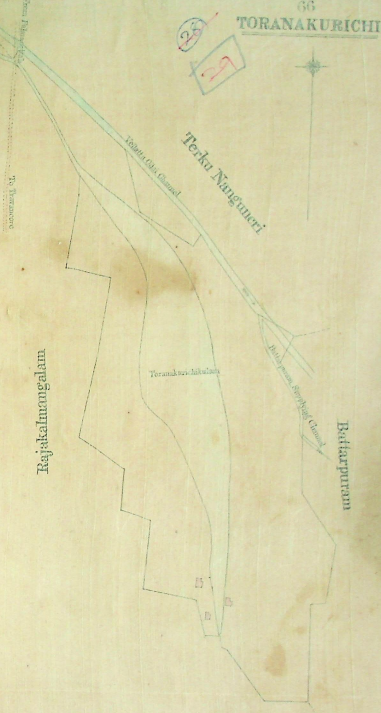
Pasturage. Nos. 21, 22, 24 and 26, have been set aside for this purpose.

Building site. Is sufficient for present requirements.

No pattah will be granted for cultivation within the limits of the Building site, and no new enclosure is to be made, or new building erected without permission in future.

Taxes. The Charabegam, and Sippanthari deductions, amounting to Rupees 4-8-1, and Rupees 2-3-3, respectively have been resumed.
